

SPONBILL CAMPSITE, PUBLIC

Spoonbill campsite is situated along the grant plain overlooking the Spoonbill dam. The dam is frequently visited by a variety of wildlife, and spoonbill birds, especially in the dry season.

Spoonbills are tall white waterbirds with long broad black bills and black legs. They fly with necks and legs extended. In the water, they feed with elegant sideward sweeps of their bill. In the breeding season, adults show some yellow on their chest and bill tip.

Spoonbill is a public campsite and thus booking of the facility will not be exclusive.



GETTING THERE:

About three (3) and a half hours drive from Nairobi.

One (1) hour drive from Nanyuki Airstrip.

CAMPSITE DOS AND DON'TS

Do not leave any food or leftovers in the open as this may attract wild animals.

Remember the rule is not to feed the wild animals in their natural environment.

If you are on a public campsite, be mindful of other campers.

Do not distract other campers by playing music, or having conversations that make other campers uncomfortable.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. All campsites are equipped with clean camp toilets, dustbins and fire-pits. A water bowser and firewood will also be provided
2. Campers must carry all of their own camping equipment, food and drink
3. It is mandatory that campers and any ground crew sign the indemnity form on entry into the Conservancy
4. Camping is available throughout the year however during the rainy seasons April /May and September/October campsites are only accessible in a 4WD vehicle.

NOT INCLUDED:

1. Ol Pejeta Conservancy entrance fees are payable at the gate on arrival for each night of your stay.
2. On site activities including guided night game drives, lion tracking and bush walks. These can be booked ahead of your visit, or on arrival (subject to availability)

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR CAMPERS

Please note that for your safety and to ensure compliance with conservation protocols, it is **mandatory** to have an armed ranger accompany you during your camping experience at Ol Pejeta Conservancy.

A fee of **Ksh 5,000** per ranger per night applies.
